This document is a resource for organisers and hosts of a Voice to Parliament talk or forum. The event is hosted and organised by you. We provide the presenters/speakers and some information resources.

Voice Info Sessions are fact-based sessions designed to increase understanding around constitutional recognition of First Nations Australians and the Voice to Parliament. The tone of these sessions is respectful and welcomes curiosity - genuine questions are encouraged.

Format – 1hr (30 minutes on presentation and 30 minutes on Q&A)

The info session is co-presented by a First Nations and non-indigenous presenter. These presenters are unpaid volunteers.

- Acknowledgement of Country
- 20-30 minute slide presentation
- Pre-gathered questions from event convener
- Q&A opened up to the audience

The pre-gathered questions are a useful way of ensuring that key and commonly asked questions are prioritised within the session. It can also be a way of consolidating similar questions to cover the most ground.
